On Monday children were enthralled by School Magic as well as being reminded about how important it is to "Stop, Look, Listen and Think" before crossing the road.



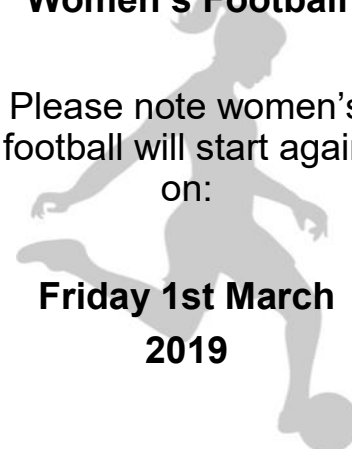
Teddy Bear Hospital
