

Nursery Maths Key Instant Recall Facts

On this sheet you will find the key instant recall facts for your child's year group. By the end of the year your child must be able to recall these facts instantly. We will work on this in school and would appreciate your support at home.

Recite number names in order to 10

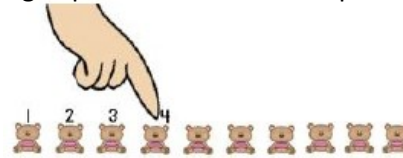
Children should say the number names in order from 0 to 10. Start at 0 and then count on. Ask them to count a set of objects and touch them as they count. Check they can say one number for each object.

Touch counting

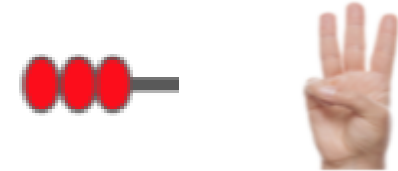
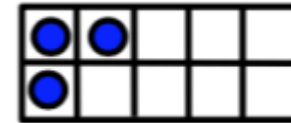
Children will sometimes count objects more than once or miss an object out that needs to be counted. Encourage your child to line up objects and touch each one as they count saying one number per object. This will also help to avoid children counting more quickly than they touch the objects which again shows they have not grasped one-to-one correspondence.



Take your finger, touch the object and count. Keep your finger on the object until you say the number. Touch and count each object you see.

Subitise up to 3

Children should be able to recognise a small group of objects (up to 3) without needing to count them.



Sort objects and say which group is more/less

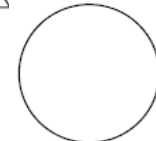
