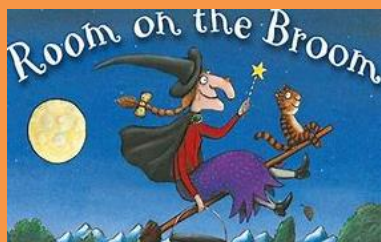


Nursery Pick and Mix Spring 1

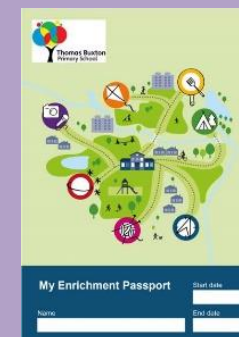
Get Creative
