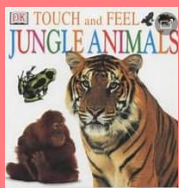


Nursery Homework Pick and Mix Summer 2026

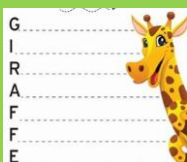
Get Reading

Get Writing

Write a diary and draw some pictures about what you enjoy doing on a sunny day.

Go on an insect hunt in your local park. Can you move like different insects?
