

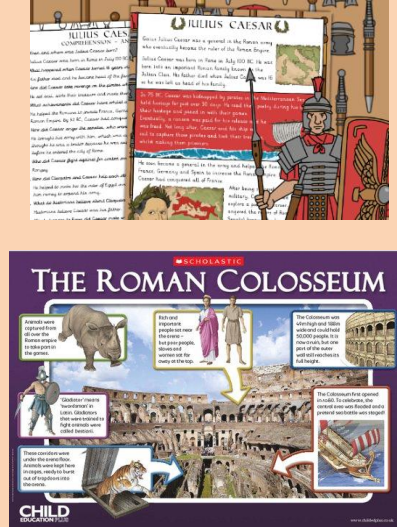
Get Reading
