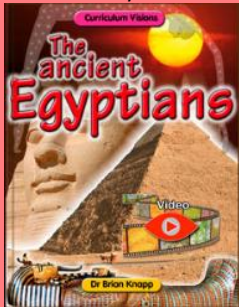


Year 4 Homework Pick and Mix
