Get Creative

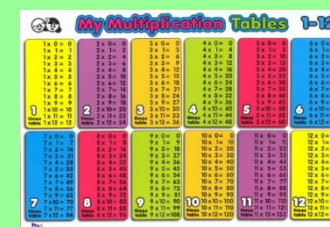
