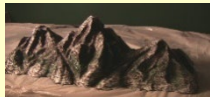


Year 6 Homework – Pick and Mix – Autumn 2025

We would love you to bring any information you have found back to school! 	<u>Get Speaking</u> Can you retell your favourite fictional narrative to a family member using ambitious vocabulary? Try to use 5 words that you've never used before! Create a poster of the 5 ambitious words that you used!	<u>Get Creative</u> Can you create a model of a mountain? We will be learning all about their features and the different types of mountains this term. 	<u>Get Mathematical</u> Can you create a budget for a holiday if you were to visit a famous mountain range? Consider the costing of the following: flights to your destination; food and drink and visiting tourist attractions. Make a spreadsheet to show your findings.

Can you research facts about a mountain range or any other physical geographical features such as rivers, lakes and coasts and write a non-chronological report? 	<u>Get Outside</u> In art we will be studying cubism.
