



Remote Learning Statement of Intent

The requirement for schools to provide remote learning expired in March 2022. However, the school follows the non-statutory guidance from the DFE regarding the offer for remote learning.

Scenarios where remote education should be considered

Circumstances where it might not be possible for pupils to receive in person education fit into 2 broad categories:

- school closures or restrictions on attendance, where school access for pupils is restricted
- individual cases where a pupil is unable to attend school but is able to learn

The school will work with families to provide remote learning taking into account the unique circumstances of the child/ren.
